Frequently Asked Questions

What do I need to have with me to get a Husky One Card (UConn ID)?

A photo ID such as a driver's license, passport, or some other official picture ID. Employees will also need to bring a copy of their payroll authorization or a letter from their Department.

Where is the One Card Office located?

- Second floor of the Wilbur Cross building, Storrs.
- Gampel Student Center- 3rd floor Undergraduate Building- West Hartford (85 Lawler Rd., West Hartford 06117)

What do I do if I lose my ID?

If you lose your card, deactivate it via the Manage Your Account section of this website or call the One Card Office at (860)486-3129. If you find it, you can reactivate it on the website or in person at the One Card Office. Any meals or cash lost are not refundable, so make sure to deactivate your lost card immediately.

Do ID cards expire?

Your card is valid as long as you are affiliated with the University and does not need to be renewed each year. If there is a change in status (ex. from undergraduate to graduate, name change, etc.) then a new card must be issued.

What happens if my ID stops working?

It is important to take good care of your ID card. You can buy an ID holder at the Co-op. Keeping the ID card in a holder will lessen the risk of damage. The One Card Office will replace, at no charge, any non-functioning ID card that exhibits normal wear and tear. Normal wear and tear is defined as any damage that is caused by swiping the ID card through authorized equipment. The One Card Office will charge a replacement fee of \$15 for non-functioning ID cards that are determined to be caused by improper care and handling. Examples include bent cards, gouged cards, cards with vertical scratches or gouges on the magnetic stripe. Any ID card with a hole punch that interferes with the function of the ID card will also be charged a \$15 replacement fee.

Can my friends use my ID?

No. Your ID is yours to use only. If a person is caught using someone else's ID, the ID may be confiscated. This is to safeguard any value that may be on the card.

Frequently Asked Questions (continued)

Can I pick up my friend's/child's ID card?

No. The cardholder must be the person who picks up the ID.

What can I use my ID for?

The Husky One Card has many different functions. It is used as an identification for various functions and events, to pay for printed copies at the Library and Information Technology Center, to take books out of the library, and purchases with **HUSKY Bucks**.

What are Husky Bucks?

HUSKY Bucks is a debit account on your ID to make purchases at various locations at the Storrs and regional campuses. There are several off-campus merchants near the Storrs campus that also accept **HUSKY Bucks**. Note: laundry facilities at the Storrs campus (except Mansfield Apartments) and copying and printing services at the Homer Babbidge Library only take **HUSKY Bucks**. There are no coin machines.

Can I take cash out of my account?

Cash cannot be taken out of this account. Refunds are only issued upon request if the student is graduating or has separated from the University and has a balance of \$20 or greater. There is a \$10 fee to close the account.
